Whose woods these are I think I know. His house is in the village though; He will not see me stopping here To watch his woods fill up with snow.


My little horse must think it queer




I'm not a game, yet I capture your gaze, An unending universe for ideas to raise. When books open on chairs and floors, What time is it to explore?




