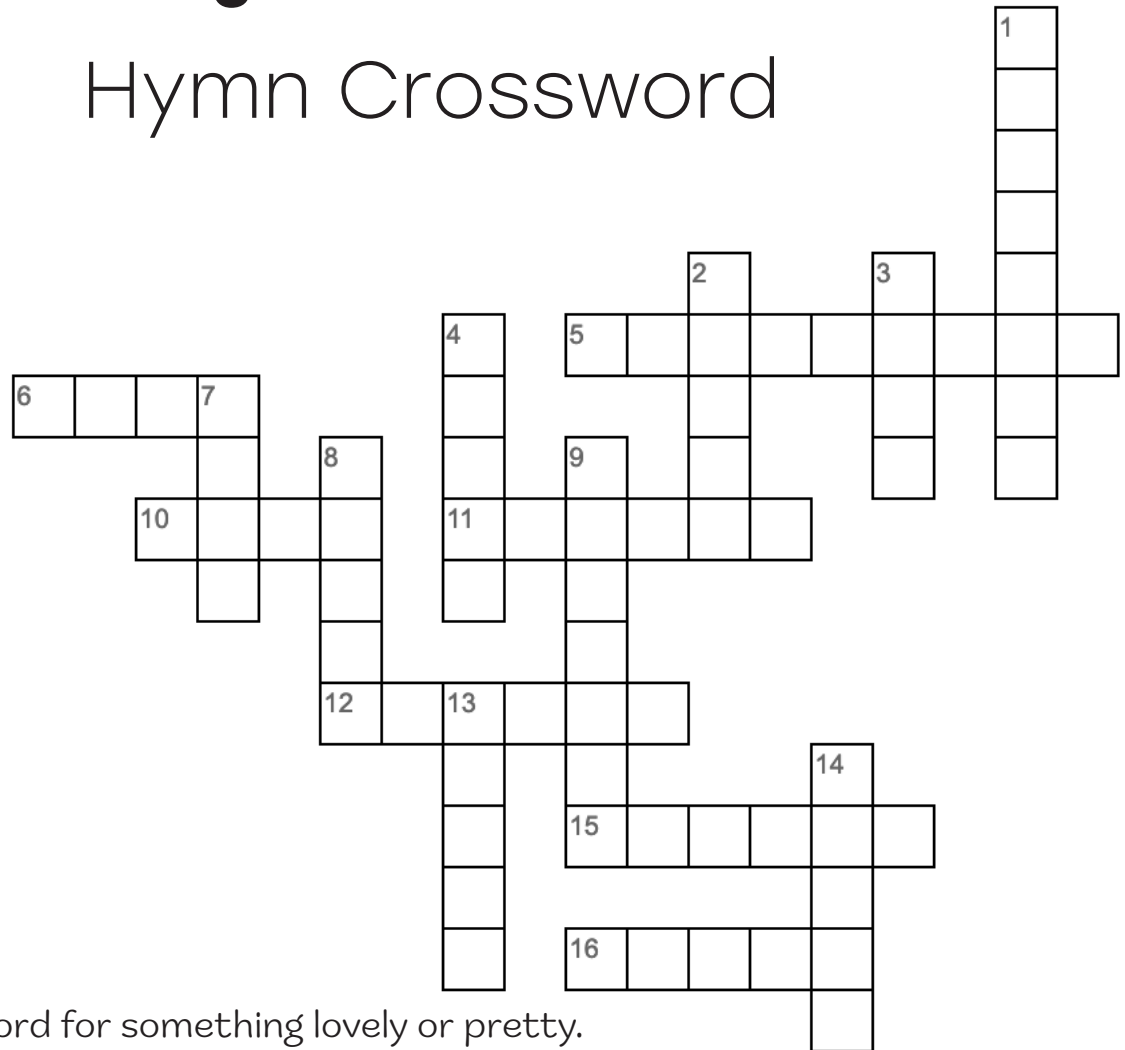
Take My Life and Let It Be

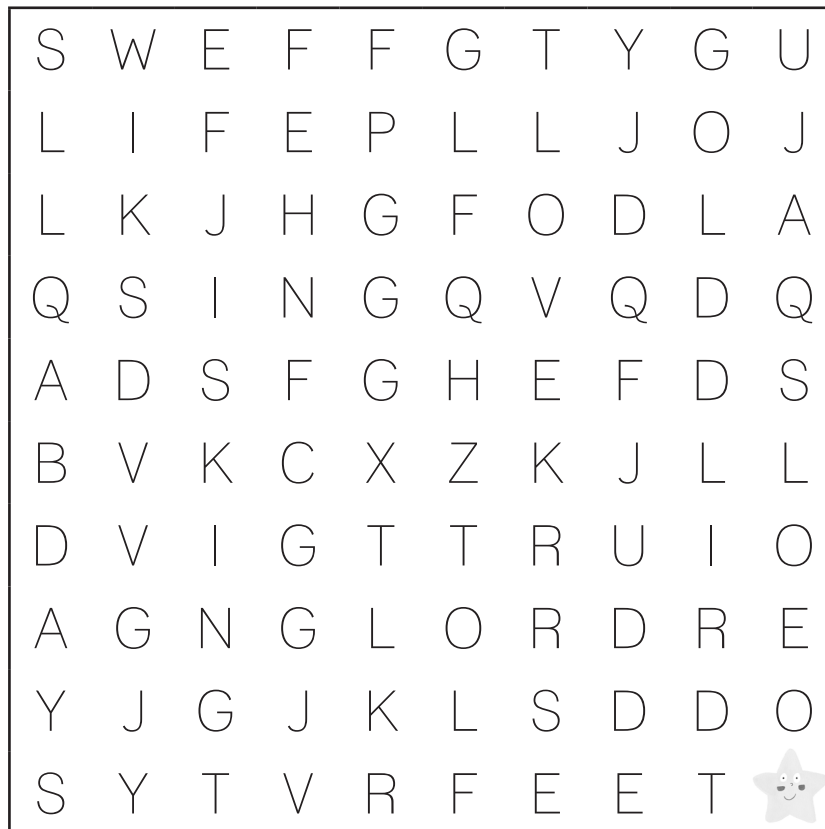

You can hear giggling when you close the door.

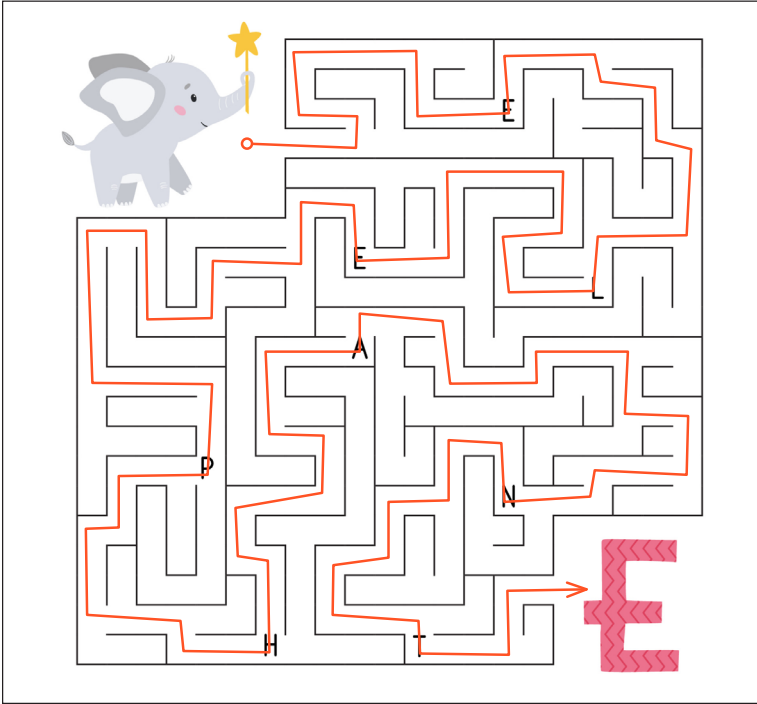

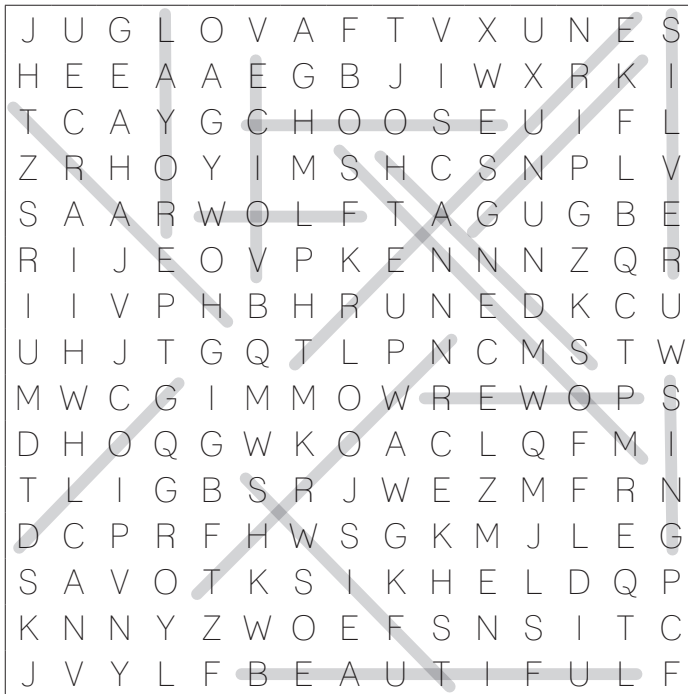

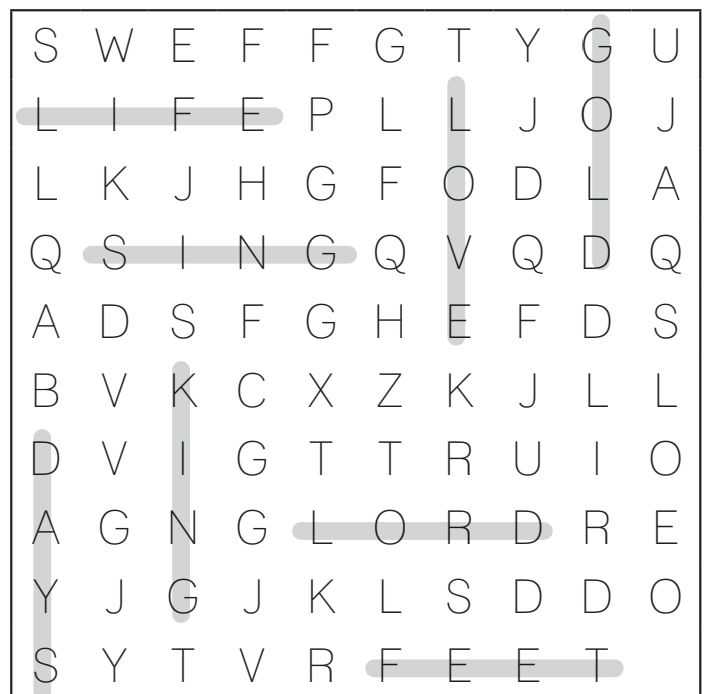
