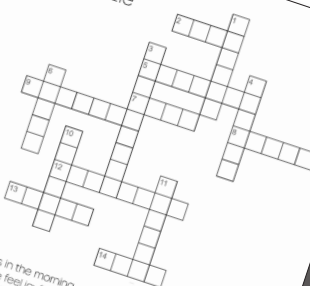

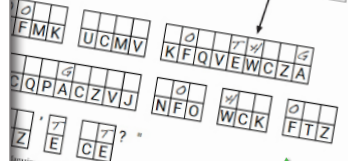

Cryptogram Puzzle Instructions

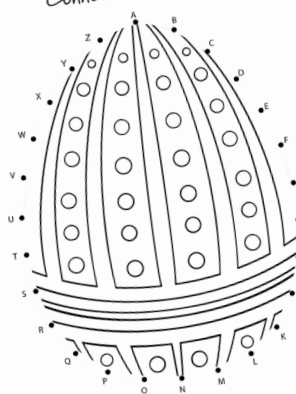
A cryptogram is a secret code where letters are replaced with different letters. Your job? Crack the code and reveal the hidden quote!
