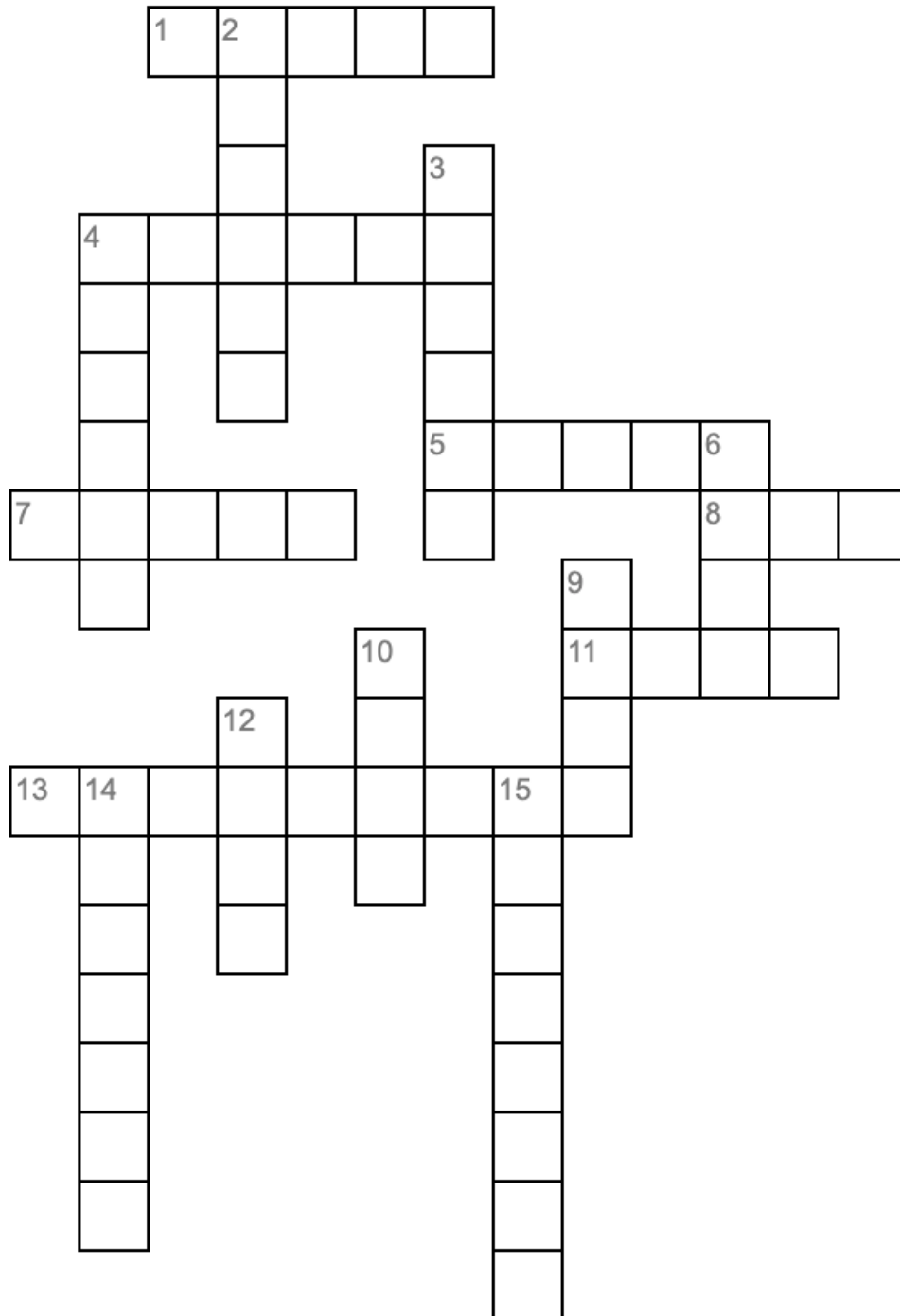
Mary had a little lamb,
