

"Write Yourself into Your Favorite Story"

For younger children, use the Watch Me Draw page to draw a picture of something from their favorite story.

Use your imagination: Have you ever thought about what it would be like to meet a character from your favorite story? Or to visit one of the places you've read about? A book is a portal that allows you to visit this different world, but writing allows you to do that, too. Authors get to use their imaginations to create a setting, where the story takes place, and its characters and how they interact. When you read a story, have you ever thought about how you would change it?

Writing Prompt: Imagine that you could become a character in your favorite story. You are now part of the story-walking and talking with the characters. What would you say? What would you do?

Some questions to get you started:
First, pick your story:
Who are the characters?
What would you say to the characters? What questions would you have for them?
What places would you want to visit?
How would you change the outcome of the story? Or would you leave it the same?
What do you like about the story? What do you dislike? How would you change that?

Now it's your turn! Start writing your story below—or draw the first scene, map out your characters, or imagine what happens next.






Cryptogram Puzzle Instructions

Song of Life (Adapted)


by Charles Mackay








Squirrel and Acorn Maze Maze 1


